- IV. New Complaints

CRB2020-0018: The Complainant alleges that she was driving in her car after leaving a community meeting, when a marked police car reckless performed a U-turn and entered her lane. This caused the complainant to pull over the curb, into a grassy incline to avoid hitting the marked police vehicle. The complainant called 911 to report the incident. A few days after the incident she received a call from BPD but has received no further information to date.

CRB2020-0019: The Complainant alleges that he was approached by a Environmental Police Officer in a negative manner when approached about parking an identified parking space. The Officer had an “aggressive vocal tone”, was incorrect in citing information, and was “rude and dismissive” before a conversation about the topic could be discussed.

V. Completed Investigation(s):

CRB2019-0126/ PIB19-1091---- (H): The Complainant alleged that he was approached and illegally stopped due to his race, the vehicle he was driving, and the area that he was visiting. Due to the Complainant’s lack of cooperation and the inability to contact the Complainant it is recommended that the case be administratively closed.

CRB2019-0136/ PIB19-1056---- (H): The Complainant alleged that Officer #1 knocked on her door looking for an individual she did not know. The Officer stated that he would provide an arrest warrant after he searched the home for the individual and that he would “come back until he found him.” The Complainant allowed the officer to search her home but was not provided a warrant of any kind. She reported this to Officer #2, who also provided false information about search and arrest warrants.

CRB2019-0104/PIB19-0624----- (EF, FA,FI): The Complainant alleged that while being interviewed by a Detective in an interrogation room, his head was pressed against the table and was held down by two other officers. The Complainant had previously, thrown his cell phone on the ground and inserted his sim card in his mouth. An officer proceeded to place his fingers in the complainant’s mouth to retrieve the sim card. The Complainant also alleges that “a small plastic bag of pills which appeared to be narcotics” were placed near him and he was accused

him of ownership of the narcotics. During this incident, the Complainant was “jumped” by three unidentified officers, causing him to “bump his head” and to be transported to the hospital.

CRB2017-0210/PIB17-0709----- (FA, FI, H): The Complainant was engaged in a dispute with a MTA bus operator in reference to securing the Complainant a seat due to his disability. The police were called to assist. The Complainant was handcuffed and escorted off the bus.

CRB 2019-0143/ PIB19-1143----- (H, EF): The Complainant alleged that harassed by an officer that she previously had a one-time personal relationship. She also alleged that an unidentified officer physically assaulted and harassed her on approximately three different occasions.
