- IV. New Complaint(s):

**CRB2020-0021:** The Complainant alleges that in the morning a unknown man was taking pictures of his home and asked to see his camera. The Complainant responded, “no.” Later that evening, the Complainant, received an alert on his Ring Bell, that depicted the Baltimore City Swat Team kicking in his front door. When the Complainant arrived, the unidentified man seen earlier, was in his home holding the same camera from earlier.

**CRB2020-0022:** The Complainant alleges that an Officer unfoundedly lied on him/her in several criminal cases, and has retaliated against him/her. As a result, the Complainant has suffered severe anxiety and panic attacks.

- V. Completed Investigation(s):

**CRB2019-0016-PIB19-0221----- (H, FI):** The Complainant was informed by the Victim that she called 911 to report her car stolen from her driveway. The responding Officer requested that she provide the vehicle’s credentials in order to complete the stolen vehicle paperwork. Later that afternoon, the responding officer returned with U.S. Immigration Custom Enforcement (ICE). The Victim in this case was deported and the Complainant conveyed the victim’s request to withdraw the complaint. This case was submitted for an administrative closure.

**CRB2019-0018/ IAD 2019-0192----- (AL, H, FI, FA)-** The Complainant alleges that he “can’t walk to his car without being harassed by some very disrespectful officers.” Additionally, the Complainant alleged that he was threatened and searched without cause. The CRB Investigator reports that the Complainant has been unresponsive and uncooperative with this investigation. This case was submitted for an administrative closure.

**CRB2018-0087/PIB2018-0345-----(H)** The Complainant alleged that her two sons have been harassed by an Officer since 2016, and that the Officer stated, “ he would not stop until he put them away.” The Complainant alleges that the Officer entered her home to execute a warrant that had her son as the subject, however he does not reside at her home.

**CRB2018-0109-----**(H) The Complainant alleged that after receiving a ticket from an Officer due to her vehicle being in a “tow away” zone. The Complainant alleged that the Officer was “aggressive, unreasonable, and needlessly” had the car towed. After the incident, The Complainant alleged that the Officer “stalked” her and obtained her identifying information in an unauthorized manner.
