

**Civilian Review Board of Baltimore City
Semi-Annual Statistical Report
January 1, 2008 through June 30, 2008**

From January 1, 2008 through June 30, 2008 80 complaints were filed.

The 80 complaints processed in this review period compares with 98 complaints filed in the preceding six months.

Additional statistical information for the period is still under review.

In the six month period from January 1, 2008 through June 30, 2008, the Civilian Review Board reviewed 56 completed investigations submitted by the Internal Affairs Division of the Baltimore Police Department. The Board reviewed 1 completed investigation from the Baltimore School Police, 0 from the Sheriff's Office, and 0 Housing Authority Police of Baltimore. The total number of allegations reviewed by the Board for the period was 139. The total number of complaints reviewed was 57.

Of the 57 complaints reviewed for the period, none was actually filed during this period.

Of the 54 allegations of excessive force reviewed by the Board, the Law Enforcement Agency involved found that 0 of the allegations was UNFOUNDED, 53 were NOT SUSTAINED, 0 was EXONERATED, and 1 was SUSTAINED. For the same 54 allegations of Excessive Force, the Civilian Review Board found 46 were NOT SUSTAINED, 0 EXONERATED, and 8 were SUSTAINED.

Of the 47 allegations of Abusive Language reviewed by the Board, the Law Enforcement Agency involved found that 4 were UNFOUNDED, 42 were NOT SUSTAINED, and 1 was SUSTAINED. For the same 47 allegations of Abusive Language the Civilian Review Board found 40 were NOT SUSTAINED, 0 was EXONERATED, and 7 were SUSTAINED.

Of the 27 allegations of Harassment reviewed by the Board, the Law Enforcement Agency involved found that 7 of the allegations were NOT SUSTAINED, 20 were UNFOUNDED, and 0 were SUSTAINED. For the same 27 allegations of Harassment, the Civilian Review Board found 26 were NOT SUSTAINED, 1 EXONERATED, and 0 was SUSTAINED.

Of the 7 allegations of False Arrest reviewed by the Board, the Law Enforcement Agency involved found that 2 of the allegations were NOT SUSTAINED, 5 were UNFOUNDED, and 0 was SUSTAINED. For the same 7 allegations of False Arrest the Civilian Review Board found 4 were NOT SUSTAINED, 0 was EXONERATED, and 3 were SUSTAINED.

Of the 4 allegations of False Imprisonment reviewed by the Board, the Law Enforcement Agency involved found that 0 of the allegations were NOT SUSTAINED, 4 were UNFOUNDED and 0 was SUSTAINED. For the same 4 allegations of False Imprisonment the Civilian Review Board found 4 were NOT SUSTAINED, 0 was EXONERATED, and 0 was SUSTAINED.

During this same period (January 1, 2008 through June 30, 2008) 80 complaints were received by the Civilian Review Board against members of the Baltimore City Police Department. There was 0 complaints filed against the School Police, Sheriff's Office, and Housing Authority Police.

Of the 80 complaints processed by the Board, a simultaneous investigation was requested to be done by the Board's investigators on 40 complaints.

The 80 complaints contacted approximately 172 allegations.
