Semi-Annual Statistical Report

In the six-month period from January 1, 2001 through June 30, 2001, the Civilian Review Board reviewed 41 completed complaint investigations by the Internal Affairs Division of the Baltimore Police Department, consisting of 48 allegations of excessive force and 37 allegations of abusive language for a total of 85 allegations. Of the 41 complaints reviewed by the Civilian Review Board during this period, none was actually filed during this period. As of June 30, 2001 (from January 1, 2001 through June 30, 2001), 63 complaints were filed with the Civilian Review Board against members of the Baltimore Police Department. Of these 63 complaints, the Civilian Review Board requested its own independent investigation be done on 20.

During this same period, one complaint was filed against a member of the Housing Authority Police of Baltimore City, and two complaints were filed against members of the Baltimore City School Police. There were no complaints filed against members of the Baltimore Sheriff's Office.

Of the 85 allegations reviewed by the Civilian Review Board, the Internal Affairs Division of the Baltimore Police Department found that 11 should be sustained, 37 not sustained, 24 *unfounded, 12 exonerated, and one administratively closed.

Of the 48 allegations of excessive force reviewed, the Civilian Review Board affirmed the findings of IAD on 27 of the allegations. Eleven unfounded findings by IAD were concluded Not Sustained by the CRB, five exonerated findings by IAD were concluded Not Sustained by the CRB, five unfounded findings by IAD were concluded Exonerated by the CRB.

Of the 37 allegations of abusive language, the CRB affirmed 23 findings of IAD. Eight findings of "unfounded" by IAD were concluded to be "not sustained" by CRB. One finding of "exonerated" by IAD was concluded to be "not sustained" by CRB. Five findings of IAD (one "unfounded", two "sustained", two "not sustained") resulted in a tie vote by the CRB, thus no recommendation was made.

* The enabling statute does not include "unfounded" as a finding to be used by the CRB.

Civilian Review Board Semi-Annual Statistical Report

The figures show that the Civilian Review Board affirmed the IAD findings on approximately 60% of the allegations reviewed. These statistics are the result of the Civilian Review Board's review of the facts and circumstances involved in each complaint, including a thorough examination of all evidence contained in the Internal Affairs Division investigative file. The Board reached its findings and recommendations by majority vote.

The 63 complaints filed with the Civilian Review Board in the first half of 2001 (January through June 30th) compares with 37 complaints filed during the second half of 2000, and with 45 complaints filed during the first half of 2000.

Completed investigations by the CRB investigators are held until completed investigations by IAD are forwarded, so that Board members may have the benefit of analyzing both investigations.

The attached charts provide statistical summaries on the allegations, complainants, and officers involved in the 63 complaints filed during the review period between January 1, 2001 and June 30, 2001.






Complaint Summary Information On Allegations <u>Filed</u> Between January 1, 2001 and June 30, 2001









For the review period from July 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001, the Civilian Review Board voted to reverse the findings of IAD, from Not Sustained to Sustained on a single complaint of Abusive Language.
