# CIVILIAN REVIEW BOARD of BALTIMORE CITY <br> Semi-Annual Statistical Report Summary <br> July 1, 2011 - December 31, 2011 

In the sixth-month period from July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, the Civilian Review Board received $\underline{54}$ citizen complaints filed against members of the Baltimore Police Department. During this same period, the Board received $\underline{2}$ complaints against members of the Baltimore Public School System Police, the Sheriff's Office and the Housing Authority Police.

Of the $\underline{55}$ total complaints received, the Board requested a simultaneous investigation to be conducted by its investigators on 18 complaints.

The $\underline{55}$ complaints received contained $\underline{80}$ total allegations: $\underline{32}$ excessive force, $\underline{15}$ abusive language, $\underline{12}$ harassment, $\underline{17}$ false arrest, $\underline{4}$ false imprisonment.

The $\underline{55}$ complaints received by the board during the period compare with $\underline{42}$ filed in the preceding six-month period (January 1, 2011-June 30, 2011).

In the six-month period from July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 the Civilian Review Board reviewed $\underline{54}$ completed investigations against members of the Baltimore Police Department. The Board reviewed 4 complaints against members of the Baltimore School Police. The Board reviewed $\underline{0}$ complaints against the Sheriff's Office and Housing Authority Police during this period.

Of the $\underline{55}$ completed investigations reviewed during this period, none were actually filed during the period.

The $\underline{55}$ completed investigations reviewed contained approximately $\underline{38}$ allegations of excessive force, $\underline{32}$ allegations of abusive language, $\underline{12}$ allegations of harassment, $\underline{22}$ allegations of false arrest, and $\underline{9}$ allegations of false imprisonment, for a total of $\underline{113}$ allegations or findings being reviewed.

Of the $\underline{113}$ findings reviewed The Civilian Review Board recommended that a not sustained finding by Internal Investigations be reversed to a sustained finding on $\underline{0}$ allegations. The Board voted to reverse the findings of IID on approximately $\underline{0 \%}$ of the allegations (findings) reviewed.
