

**CIVILIAN REVIEW BOARD of BALTIMORE CITY**  
**Semi-Annual Statistical Report Summary**  
**July 1, 2011 – December 31, 2011**

In the sixth-month period from July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, the Civilian Review Board received 54 citizen complaints filed against members of the Baltimore Police Department. During this same period, the Board received 2 complaints against members of the Baltimore Public School System Police, the Sheriff's Office and the Housing Authority Police.

Of the 55 total complaints received, the Board requested a simultaneous investigation to be conducted by its investigators on 18 complaints.

The 55 complaints received contained 80 total allegations: 32 excessive force, 15 abusive language, 12 harassment, 17 false arrest, 4 false imprisonment.

The 55 complaints received by the board during the period compare with 42 filed in the preceding six-month period (January 1, 2011-June 30, 2011).

In the six-month period from July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 the Civilian Review Board reviewed 54 completed investigations against members of the Baltimore Police Department. The Board reviewed 4 complaints against members of the Baltimore School Police. The Board reviewed 0 complaints against the Sheriff's Office and Housing Authority Police during this period.

Of the 55 completed investigations reviewed during this period, none were actually filed during the period.

The 55 completed investigations reviewed contained approximately 38 allegations of excessive force, 32 allegations of abusive language, 12 allegations of harassment, 22 allegations of false arrest, and 9 allegations of false imprisonment, for a total of 113 allegations or findings being reviewed.

Of the 113 findings reviewed The Civilian Review Board recommended that a not sustained finding by Internal Investigations be reversed to a sustained finding on 0 allegations. The Board voted to reverse the findings of IID on approximately 0% of the allegations (findings) reviewed.
