NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES:

Under the Provisions of the Baltimore City Code, Article 5, Subtitle 26

YOU MUST BE PAID A LIVING WAGE OF

\$12.74 per hour beginning July 1, 2022

\$13.33 per hour beginning July 1, 2023

OVERTIME PAY

At least 1 ½ times the regular rate of pay for All hours worked over eight (8) in one workday; All hours worked over forty (40) in one workweek.
