All vendors who are awarded **service contracts** for certain services
In the City of Baltimore are subject to the provisions of the
Baltimore City (Living) Wage Law.
The purpose of this law is to provide for a living
Minimum hourly wage rate for worker(s) employed
By those vendors.

NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES:

Under the Provisions of the Baltimore City Code, Article 5, Subtitle 26

YOU MUST BE PAID A LIVING WAGE OF

\$12.06 per hour beginning July 1, 2019

\$12.36 per hour beginning July 1, 2020

OVERTIME PAY

At least 1 ½ times the regular rate of pay for:
All hours worked over eight (8) in one workday;
All hours worked over forty (40) in one workweek.

[The above rates apply to all contractors and subcontractors of]
Baltimore City **service contracts**.
